On May 1st, 2023, Jessica Willis, on behalf of a minor child, filed Simple Assault charges in the Pearl Municipal Court against Reneatha Gibbs for alleged misconduct that occurred on or about April 25, 2023.



Subsequently, the case was transferred to the Rankin County Justice Court, who assumed jurisdiction over the matter.


